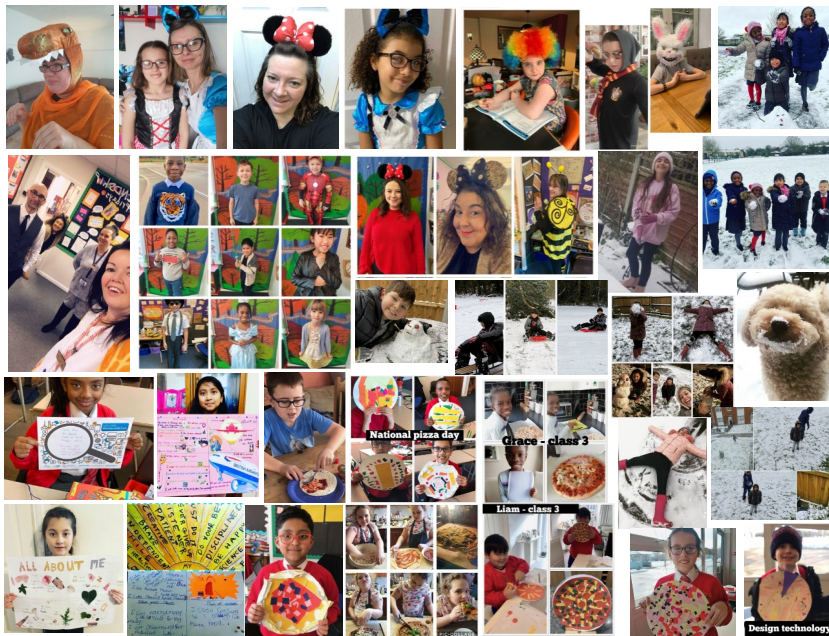
Next week is half-term week, so the children will be able to take a break from school work, and we look forward to seeing the children again on Zoom from Monday 22nd February.
