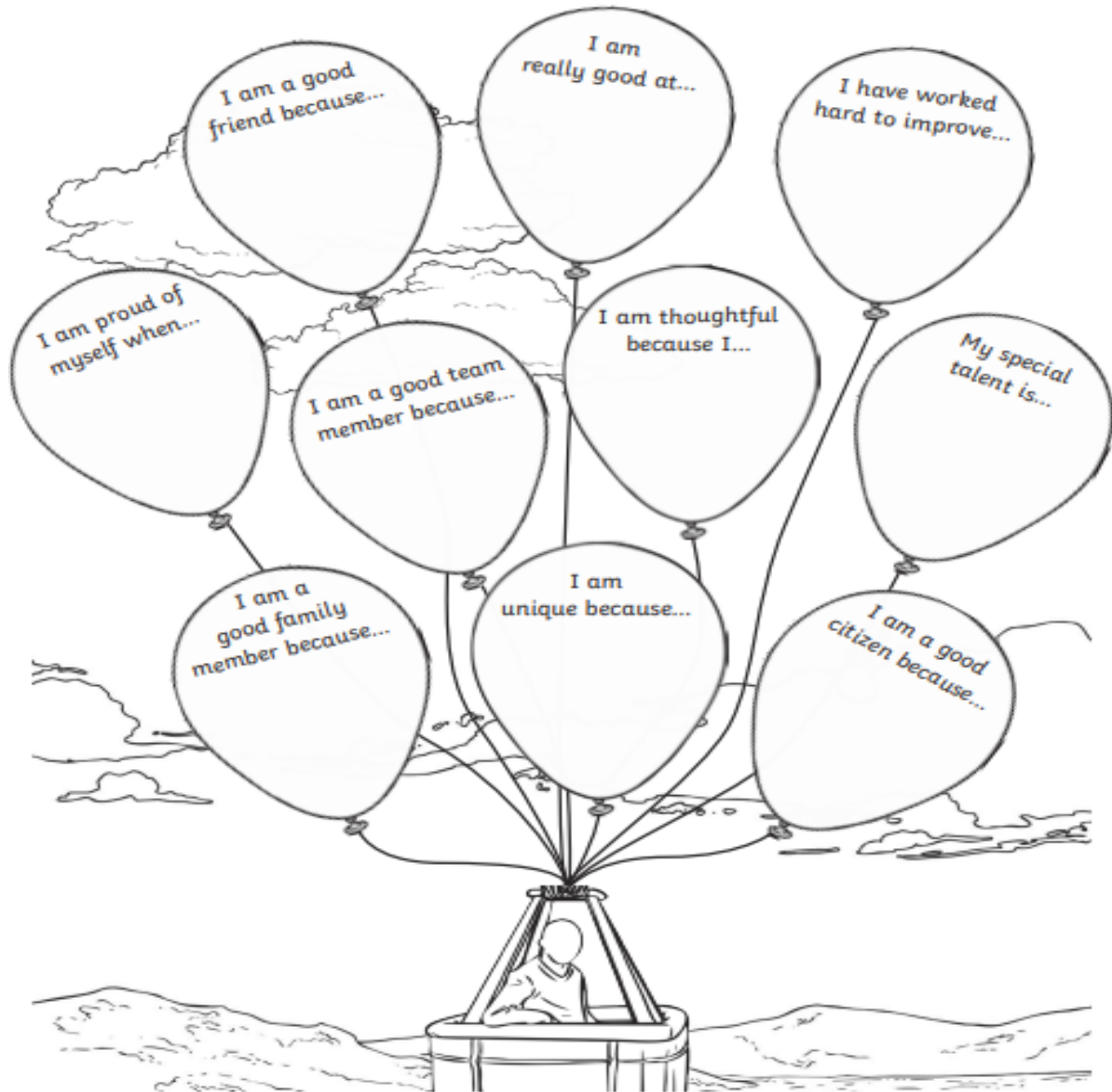
MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING
