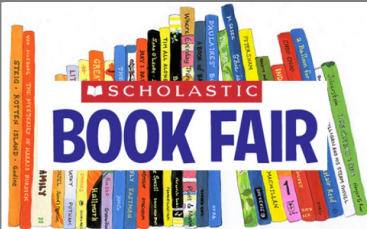
FEELINGS
