

Free School Meals

You can make an application for your child to receive free school meals. Applications can be made online at https://pps.lgfl.org.uk

If you receive any of the following benefits, you may be eligible:

• Income Support • Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance • Income-related Employment and Support Allowance • Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 • The guaranteed element of Pension Credit • Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190) • Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit • Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than \pounds 7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).
